## Redetermination Dates

At this critical moment, the unwinding of the PHE and the complexities of redetermination will present many challenges for Medicaid members, the workforce that supports them, and healthcare providers throughout the country. Terminations for individuals the state has redetermined as ineligible for Medicaid and CHIP may occur on or after April 1, 2023.
