

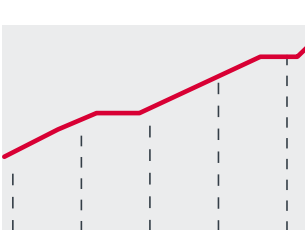
Healthcare Costs

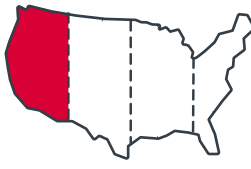

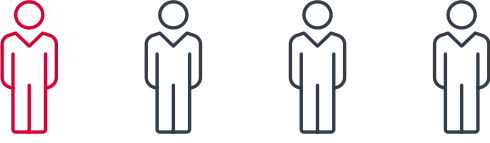

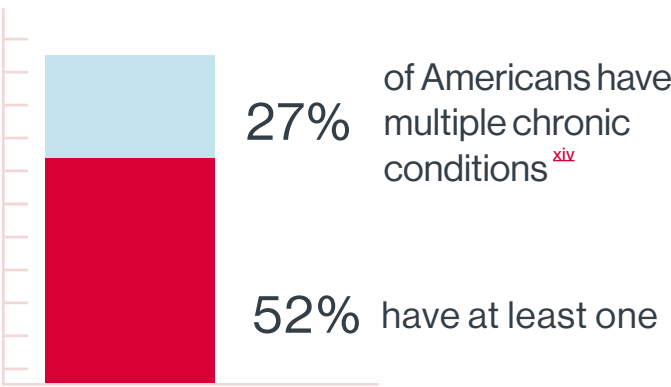
